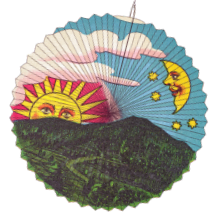




Follow the clues and track down the animals hidden along the Kew Junction High Street (plus see some other lovely artworks along the way)



Start at NK Nail Salon – 113 High Street Kew (on the big Junction)

1. Found between 113 – 139 High Street. Loves to hang around and plays a King in The Jungle Book.
2. Stop a little at Brougham Street and take in our Kew 3101 mural, painted in conjunction with Q Art Gallery – a local gallery that only employs mentally and physically disabled artists. How many things can you pick out from the mural that shows what the Q Art, and mural artist, love about Kew?
3. Found between 141 – 181 High Street. Is man's best friend and knows how to sit and fetch.
4. Found between 185 – 217 High Street. Clean themselves, make a funny sound when they're happy and like to do whatever they please!
5. Found between 185 – 217 High Street. We love to ride them and they can run, dance, jump fences and more.
6. Found between 221 – 251 High Street. The world's largest land animal with a memory you wish you had!
7. Found between 259 – 299 High Street. The world's tallest land animal that can eat leaves from the tops of trees. NOTE: depending on the direction you're coming from, this one may be harder to find



Cross at the lights and head to Big Swing Golf at 320 High Street:

8. Found between 330 – 320 High Street. Sits in trees all day chewing on leaves. Most definitely isn't a bear!
9. Found between 308 – 278 High Street. Always found in groups, standing and looking about to see what's happening around them. NOTE: depending on the direction you're coming from, this one may be harder to find
10. Stop a little at Now & Then Café, 204 High Street, to take in the lovely mural on the wall in their alleyway, bringing a little nature and colour to the High Street. Can you see the path leading through the jungle? Where do you think it's going?



Cross Cotham Road at the lights at the War Memorial. When crossed, take a left and walk past Cotham Dining towards Queen Street:

11. Stop a little just around the corner of Eastern Pearl Noodle Bar, 38 Cotham Road, to take in our This is our Kew-Munity mural. What are all the different types of people you can see that make up our community?
12. Found between 38 – 2 Cotham Road. A winged and feathered friend you'll often find singing on a swing.
13. Found between 176 – 126 High Street. They're only small but they still make people squeal and jump up onto chairs.





Cheats Page



Start at NK Nail Salon – 113 High Street Kew (on the big Junction)

1. Hiatus – 117 High Street – a monkey hanging on the pipe on the front of the business
2. Brougham Street Kew 3101 mural
3. Skinny Dog Hotel – 155 High Street – a dog with his mouth open on the pipe hole on the wall
4. Via Verona – 193 High Street – a cat on top of the window sill
5. Toscano's – 213/219 High Street – a horse in a stable on the little square box in the front of the business
6. Dawson – 241 High Street – an elephant with the tap as his trunk
7. Frank & Harri – 259 High Street – a baby giraffe on the side wall (facing McDonald's)



Cross at the lights and head to Big Swing Golf at 320 High Street:

8. Big Swing Golf – 320 High Street – a koala holding onto the pipe
9. Dynamic Health Physio – 280 High Street – meerkats popping out of the grass on the side of the business
10. Now & Then Café mural



Cross Cotham Road at the lights at the War Memorial. When crossed, take a left and walk past Cotham Dining towards Queen Street:

11. Queen Street 'This is our Kew-Munity' mural
12. MBE Kew – 16 Cotham Road – a budgie on a swing hanging from the hook
13. Promolink – 140 High Street – a mouse squeezing through the grate in front of the business, and another waiting to go in
